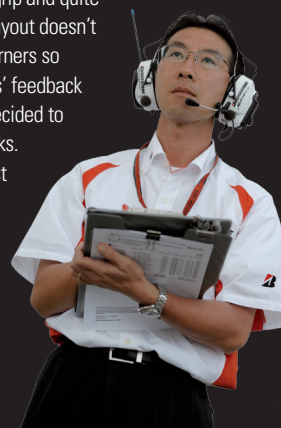

With the change of date the temperature is higher than it would have been in April so we have amended our compound selection to go one step harder front and rear. The track surface is high-grip and quite abrasive, and the circuit layout doesn't feature many left-hand corners so this year, along with riders' feedback from last year, we have decided to bring asymmetric rear slicks. We continuously study last year's data in an effort to refine our compound specifications and we listen to the riders and Motegi is a good example of this. 📢📢

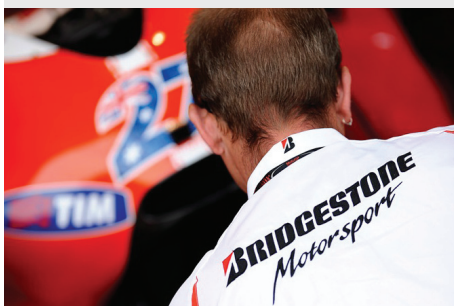

TEAM NEWS

STONER ADDS ANOTHER TO THE TALLY

Casey Stoner scored his 21st MotoGP victory at Aragon, every one of them having come using Bridgestone tyres. The Australian is still the rider with the highest number of wins on Bridgestone tyres in a single season, with ten victories en route to the title in 2007. That season, Stoner scored 14 podiums, which is second to Valentino Rossi's 16 in 2008, but with five races remaining, Jorge Lorenzo is set to challenge this record.



LORENZO LOSES PODIUM CLEAN SWEEP

Jorge Lorenzo's unbroken run of podium finishes this year came to an end at Aragon, but he has secured 24 podiums in the 30 races since the start of 2009 when he switched to Bridgestone tyres. He currently has twelve top-three finishes this year, equal to the number of podiums he achieved last season when, in every race he finished, he was only outside the top three on one occasion with fourth place.



BAUTISTA 'CERTAIN WE CAN DO BETTER'

Rizla Suzuki rookie Alvaro Bautista has been having a strong debut season in the premier class. He has scored three consecutive eighth places at the last three grands prix, and scored a MotoGP career best result of fifth in front of home fans at Catalunya in July. Nevertheless, when the Spaniard returns to the scene of the first of his two 250cc victories last year, Twin Ring Motegi, he's hoping to up his pace in Suzuki's homeland.

All qualifying practices are cancelled due to weather conditions. In accordance to article 1.16.3 of the 2009 FIM Road Racing World Championship Grand Prix Regulations, grid positions for races are defined according to Combined Free Practice times.

FACT

During last year's Japanese Grand Prix, only two sessions throughout the weekend were dry: the first free practice and the race. The downpour soaked FP2 and caused qualifying to be cancelled, so Bridgestone will bring the soft compound wet tyres to Motegi.



BRIDGESTONE MOTORSPORT ROUND-UP

F1 As this stat sheet goes to print, the Formula One World Championship is embarking on its overseas gaggle races as the championship reaches its climax. The Singapore, Japanese and Korean Grands Prix precede the final back-to-back pairing of Brazil and Abu Dhabi as the title tussle rages with the top five split by just 24 points.

GP2 At the Italian Grand Prix, the last European event for the series this year, Pastor Maldonado wrapped up the GP2 Series title race to be crowned 2010 Champion. Sam Bird won the first race at Monza, and Christian Vietoris took victory in the second. The final round of the series is in Abu Dhabi on 13-14 November.

IndyCar The IndyCar title race is reaching fever pitch. Helio Castroneves won last time out at the Indy Japan 300 at Motegi, but crucially Dario Franchitti was second ahead of points leader Will Power in third, reducing the gap to just 12 points with just the Cafes Do Brasil Indy 300 to run on 2 October. Castroneves moves into third overall just four points ahead of Scott Dixon.
